Tours of the Gault Site are given to group of 10+ people by members of the GSAR staff. School tours are free of charge , all other tours are \$10/person with all proceeds going to benefit the GSAR's educational and research programs. Our tours cover cultural, environmental and geological aspects of the site from the modern age back to 15,000 years ago. We demonstrate primitive technologies and visitors are able to learn about research excavation at the site.

Tours take roughly three hours depending on the group makeup, size and interests and cover approximately 1 1/2 miles of moderate walking. Good walking shoes, or boots (if it has rained recently) are a must. Also suggested are a camera, hat, sunscreen and water for the walk.
